Timeline of 2025 Canonizations

September 7, 2025

- **St. Pier Giorgio Frassati:** A young Italian activist and mountain enthusiast known for his deep charity toward the poor.
- **St. Carlo Acutis:** The first millennial saint and "patron saint of the internet," a teenager who used digital media to spread devotion to the Eucharist.

October 19, 2025

- **St. Bartolo Longo:** An Italian lawyer and former Satanist who became the "Apostle of the Rosary".
- **St. José Gregorio Hernández:** Known as the "Doctor of the Poor," he is one of the first saints from Venezuela.
- **St. María del Carmen Rendiles:** **Foundress of the servants of Jesus and Venezuela's first female saint.**



The Old Testament Roots of Sainthood

- The Hebrew word often translated for saints is “qedoshim- meaning holy ones, those who belong with God.
 - Used for Angels in Deut. 33:2
 - Used for God's covenant people (Psalms 34:90)
 - yes , I worked the name in two sermons in a row
 - Tied to the idea of covenant Loyalty and holy living.





Truth is... saints are simply God's people-
those who are set apart in Christ.

Saints are those who have been set apart by God.

- 1 Corinthians 1:2 paul writes to believers who are "sanctified in Christ Jesus, called as saints
- Paul calls the Corinthians saints, even though they struggled with immaturity and sin.
- The word saint (hagios) means holy, set apart, belonging of God
- Sainthood is not earned-it is declared by God through Christ.

What we do

- You don't grow into sainthood, you grow from sainthood
- Your identity is rooted in God's call, not your past.

Saints are being transformed by the Holy Spirit

- 2 Corinthians 3:19 (NASB)
 - "The wisdom of this world is foolishness before God..."
- Saints are not perfect-they are in process
- Jesus didn't just save us, HE shapes us.
 - Invite the spirit to work in all places
 - Holiness is not self-effort, it is spirit empowered transformation.


